WHAT IS THE PATIENT ADVISORY BOARD (PAB)?

The PAB represents the voice of patients. Members' lived experiences help the team identify and define barriers within the health care system and provide input on the community impact of regional health care issues.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

PAB members must have recent experience navigating the health care system without insurance, under Medicaid or Medicare coverage, or through the Gateway to Better Health Program.



ROLE OF A PAB MEMBER

A PAB member is a volunteer who advises and offers guidance on the work of the RHC based on their background knowledge and lived experience. Advisory board members have influenced the work of the Commission with their recommendations, and as such, initiatives and work groups have been developed over the years in response to feedback.
